RE: 2008-2009 Membership Application

Reminder: The USFSA calendar year runs from July 1, 2008 to June 30, 2009. Those skaters competing at Regionals must have renewed their USFSA membership prior to the September 1 competition form deadline to be eligible to compete!

Enclosed is your 2008-2009 USFSA and Columbus Figure Skating Club application. Early renewal will allow more timely receipt of your membership cards and ice contracts. Everyone skating at OSU ice rink must be a current USFSA/CFSC member. Please do not let your membership lapse if you plan on testing or competing later this summer.

Members that renew before June 25, 2008 may take a \$5 discount on their membership fee. Renewals postmarked after June 25 will be charged the full rate.

Those who specify the Columbus Figure Skating Club as their home club will receive priority contract and other session and activity scheduling over non-home club members. Following is a capsule explanation of Home Club membership. (For further clarification, see MR 6.06 in the USFSA Official Rule Book.) Only persons who intend to be home club members of the Columbus Figure Skating Club should pay the home club fee and join the USFSA through CFSC. Anyone who desires to represent another USFSA club as a competitor or official of any kind, or serve on the council thereof, should join the CFSC as a non-home club member and should submit their USFSA form via their home club. All persons skating on CFSC sessions must hold membership in the CFSC with the exception of guest privileges for USFSA members from clubs outside of a fifty mile radius of Columbus who also actually reside outside of this area. Area college students who wish to maintain a different home club status must also join the CFSC to skate on club sessions during the academic year.

NOTE: Senior members, please indicate your birth date. The USFSA has specifically requested that you give a date. Please do not put 'adult' in the space. Your application will be held until the correct date is provided.
