Everyone skating at OSU ice rink must be a current USFSA/CFSC member. Please do not let your membership lapse if you plan on testing or competing later this summer.

**Home Club Members that renew before June 13, 2011 may take a \$5 discount on the first family membership fee. Renewals postmarked after June 13 will be charged the full rate. Please complete a separate form for each member.**

2009-2010 was a great year for the CFSC. Some of our highlights: We have a new National Singles and Pair Judge. The Holiday Season Competition and the Spring Ice Show were very successful. We will host 5 test sessions. Did you know some clubs host only one test session per year? We have 12 new gold medalists.
